Advertisement inviting applications for PDCC courses in IPGME&R, Kolkata

IPGME&R, Kolkata, will be commencing 1-year Post-doctoral Certificate Courses (PDCC) in the following disciplines:

PDCC	Seats	Applicable MD / MS / DNB qualification	
Nephropathology	4	Pathology	
Neuroanesthesia	4	Anesthesiology	
Neuroradiology	2	Radiology (Radiodiagnosis)	
Interventional Radiology	2	Radiology (Radiodiagnosis)	

The courses are full time, stipendiary and affiliated to the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS). Candidates who are Indian citizens are eligible to apply if they fulfill the following criteria:

- Not enrolled in any other course.
- Has the basic qualification (MD / MS / DNB) as specified in the table above.
- Qualified in NEET-SS 2020 examination.
- In-service candidates can apply if they produce appropriate NOC from their employer.

Session will be from 01.07.2021 to 30.06.2022. Eligible and interested candidates are to appear in a **walk-in counselling session to be conducted on June 10, 2021**, at Lecture Theater 5, 2nd Floor, Academic Building, IPGME&R. Timing will be from 11:00 AM to 12:00 Noon for PDCC Nephropathology, 12:30 PM to 1:30 PM for PDCC Neuroanesthesia and 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM for PDCCC Neuroradiology and PDCC Interventional Radiology.

Candidates must bring 2 recent color passport size photographs and the following testimonials in original with 1 set of self-attested photocopies:

- 1. Valid Photo ID proof (AADHAAR card / Voter card / Passport)
- 2. Date of Birth proof
- 3. Medical Council Registration Certificate
- 4. NEET-SS 2020 Admit card
- 5. NEET-SS 2020 Result (Score) Sheet
- 6. Postgraduate Qualification (Degree) Certificate of University / Autonomous Institute / DNB Board
- 7. Marksheet of MD/MS/DNB Final Examination

Selected candidates will be enrolled in the course full time and will:

- Draw stipend at par with 3rd year MD/MS trainees. However, those who are in government service and joining
 the course under TR will draw their salary from their place of posting and will not be eligible for stipend from the
 institute.
- Pay admission fee of Rs. 18,050/- (Rupees Eighteen thousand and fifty) only at the time of admission, same as
 with other postdoctoral trainees, of which Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand) only will be refundable security
 deposit. However, security deposit will be forfeited if the course is discontinued by the candidate prematurely.
- Pay Tuition fees at the rate of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only per month, again at par with other postgraduate trainees.
- Not be entitled to hostel facility.
