Advertisement for mop-up round counseling for vacant seats in PDCC courses in IPGME&R, Kolkata

The first round of walk-in counseling for PDCC courses in various disciplines was conducted on 10.06.2021. The second round was conducted on 16.06.2021. The following are vacant seats for mop-up counseling:

PDCC	Vacant Seats	Applicable MD / MS / DNB qualification
Nephropathology	1	Pathology
Neuroanesthesia	3	Anesthesiology
Neuroradiology	2	Radiology (Radiodiagnosis)

The courses are full time, stipendiary and affiliated to the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS). Candidates who are Indian citizens are eligible to apply if they:

- Are not enrolled in any other course.
- Have the basic qualification (MD / MS / DNB) as specified in the table above.
- NEET-SS 2020 qualified or appeared candidates will get preference.
- In-service candidates can appear if they produce appropriate NOC from their employer.

Session will be from 01.07.2021 to 30.06.2022. Eligible and interested candidates are to appear in a **walk-in counselling session to be conducted on June 23, 2021 (Wednesday)**, at Lecture Theater 4, 1st Floor, Academic Building, IPGME&R. Timing will be from 12:00 Noon to 2:00 PM.

Candidates must bring 2 recent color passport size photographs and the following testimonials in original with 1 set of self-attested photocopies:

- 1. Valid Photo ID proof (AADHAAR card / Voter card / Passport)
- 2. Date of Birth proof
- 3. Medical Council Registration Certificate
- 4. NEET-SS 2020 Admit card (if appeared in NEET-SS 2020)
- 5. NEET-SS 2020 Result (Score) Sheet (if appeared in NEET-SS 2020)
- 6. Postgraduate Qualification (Degree) Certificate of University / Autonomous Institute / DNB Board
- 7. Marksheet of MD/MS/DNB Final Examination (Mark statement must be produced by DNB passed candidate)
- 8. Marksheet of MBBS 3rd Professional Part 2 examination and Internship Completion Certificate.

Final selection will be on the basis of age, successful verification of relevant documents and marks in the relevant examination (NEET-SS 2020 or MD/MS/DNB). Decision of the Counseling Committee will be final in this regard.

Selected candidates will be enrolled in the course full time and will:

- Draw stipend at par with 3rd year MD/MS trainees. However, those who are in government service and joining
 the course under TR / Special leave will draw their salary from their place of posting and will not be eligible for
 stipend from the institute.
- Pay admission fee of Rs. 18,050/- (Rupees Eighteen thousand and fifty) only at the time of admission, same as
 with other postdoctoral trainees, of which Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand) only will be refundable security
 deposit. However, security deposit will be forfeited if the course is discontinued by the candidate prematurely.
- Pay tuition fees at the rate of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only per month, again at par with other postgraduate trainees.
- Not be entitled to hostel facility at present.
- Not be involved in private practice of any kind.
